



Caravan parking spaces for the World Dog Show 2017 - Important information for your reservation and stay

Opening hours:

The overnight caravan spaces for the World Dog Show 2017 in Leipzig are open **24 hours** every day from **6 November 2017** to **14 November 2017**.

Prices:

Caravans A1/A2: EUR 80.00 / night

Caravans B1: EUR 40.00 / night

Checkin:

- from 14:00 hours
- at Gate Nord 1: for A1 and A2
- at the truck reporting point: for B1

You must submit your order confirmation to obtain your parking pass.

Checkout:

- from 14:00 hours

Equipment:

Caravans A1/A2:

- Fenced-in area in the open area directly on the exhibition grounds (see site plan)
- Electricity supplied from junction
- Use of sanitary facilities
- Withdrawal point for drinking water
- Disposal (waste water, faecal matter)
- Refuse containers
- Shower containers

Caravans B1:

- Area adjacent to exhibition grounds
- Refuse containers

Shopping options:

- "Sachsenpark" (outside of exhibition grounds)

Directions:Cars/caravans:

- Via A14, exit Leipzig-Messegelände, Messe-Allee or via B2 (Maximilian-Allee) – Messe-Allee

Local public transit:

- *Rapid transit railway (S-Bahn), regional train and RegionalExpress:*
Services: 500 metres from entrance hall West, high frequency, ten minutes to the city centre
- *Tram:* Route 16 stop in the immediate vicinity of entrance hall West, approximately 20 minutes to the city centre

The floor space is calculated on the basis of the actually used number of days (installation, trade fair and dismantling period).

Cars that serve as towing trailer are entitled to park on the parking areas A1, A2 and B1 including the caravan. Any further accompanying vehicles have to be placed on the parking areas P1 and P2. The parking areas A1, A2 and B1 have limited capacities and are restricted to vehicles serving as overnight accommodation, only.

Placements are assigned by the parking lot manager in accordance with the parking options available inside the grounds. There is no entitlement to obtain a specific parking space.

The staff that monitors the parking lot will ensure that vehicles are properly assigned and parked. No liability is assumed for personal injury and property damages as well as the theft of / from vehicles.

The electrical system in a motor caravan/caravan must be inspected by an accredited electrician at least every six months in accordance with the Accident Prevention Regulation VBG 4 Section 5. The inspection certificate that documents the correct status within the aforementioned inspection period must be submitted at request prior to connecting the motor caravan/caravan.
